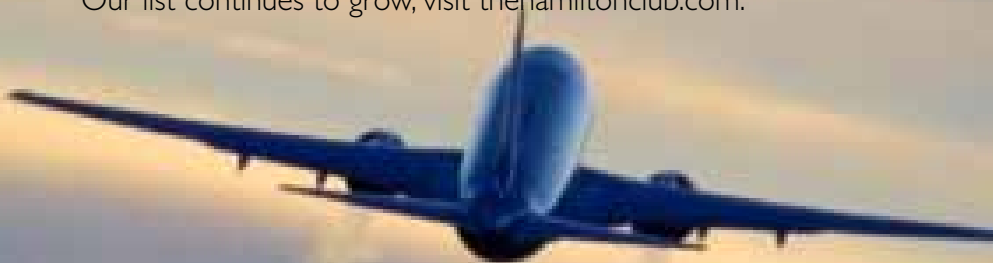

Hours of Operation (Administration)

Monday to Friday: 9:00 am - 5:00 pm

Breakfast is served:

Monday to Friday from 8:00am - 11:30am
Early reservations can be arranged with notice.

Lunch is served:

Monday to Friday from 11:30am to 2:00pm
Early or late reservations may be arranged with notice.

Dinner is served:

Wednesday to Saturday from 5:00pm. The kitchen closes at 8:00 pm with no reservations present. Early or late reservations may be arranged with notice.

Please note:

Summer Hours (June, July & August) are subject to change. The Club is closed on Sundays & closed for dinner service Monday and Tuesday.

For security purposes, the front and side doors are closed to incoming traffic early morning and at dusk. Please buzz for entry or use your key card at the James Street entrance during service hours. To arrange a private event or dining at alternative hours, please contact the Club at (905) 522-4675.

How do I make a reservation?

Reservations are encouraged but not required. We do strongly suggest reservations are made for dinner, breakfast or during alternate dining hours.

Can a guest of mine treat me?

Absolutely! Guests may pay with credit card day of or can be arranged in advance.

How do I handle gratuity?

A 15% gratuity is automatically charged to your dining & beverage charges. Gratuity is not charged for take-out orders.

Can the Club accommodate dietary restrictions for myself or my guests?

Yes. Members and guests are encouraged to let us know in advance of a reservation whenever possible, or simply inform your server or any restrictions.

Does the Club offer take out catering?

Yes. Take advantage of this privilege for family meals, entertaining at home or the office.

Dress Code:

Gentlemen are required to wear a jacket in our formal dining room, the Michael S. Schwenger Dining Room. The Club offers jackets to borrow, please inquire with staff. Ladies must be appropriately dressed. Jackets are not required for the months of June, July & August. Smart Casual for Lunch or Dinner is appropriate for all areas of the Club. Tailored denim is acceptable.

Dress Code for the Rooftop Terrace:

Patio Friendly dress (tailored shorts, smart sandals etc.) is appropriate for the Rooftop Terrace.

Business Papers/Laptops

Business papers, laptops, newspapers etc. are not allowed in the Michael S. Schwenger dining room. Briefcases or business papers may be left in the care of the staff on duty at the front desk.

Cellular Phones

Cellular phone calls are permitted in private meeting rooms, the Den, Business Lounge and the phone booth. Cellular phones are prohibited elsewhere in the common areas of the Club. Members are respectfully asked to remind guests of this House Rule.

Members may use smart phones in a quiet and mutually respectful manner in all rooms (including the Terrace) with the exception of the Michael S. Schwenger Dining Room.

Can I sponsor a guest to use my membership?

Yes. Business associates and/or friends or relatives of members may use the Club for luncheons or dinners, with their guests, without the Member being present, provided:

- a) The sponsoring Member personally arranges permission
- b) The sponsoring Member guarantees the payment of all costs including damages.

No person shall be extended these privileges to excess unless by the consent of the General Manager. Guests may settle payment prior to departure with credit card, or with permission charge to the sponsoring members account.

What events can I host at The Club?

The Hamilton Club offers private rooms

for mediations, negotiations, presentations, consultations and retreats. You can also reserve private rooms for family functions, special occasions and much more.

How do I reserve a private room?

Private rooms can be reserved by calling (905) 522-4675 or emailing our events coordinator directly at catering@thehamiltonclub.com. Rooms can be reserved individually or in suites, and configured to fit your requirements.

Are members charged set up fees for private room bookings?

As a general standard, members are not charged set up fees for private room bookings. For further information please speak with our special events department.

How do I use affiliate Club privileges?

Members can book reservations with our affiliated Clubs directly, or our staff will be happy to make reservations for you. Members do require a letter of introduction be sent prior to arrival. When travelling outside of the Country, members must settle payment with credit card prior to departure.

What privileges does my spouse have?

Your spouse has full access to all the same privileges that you do! Spouses are assigned a personal membership number and may charge expenses directly to their own account.



Where can I find information regarding Club events?

Your email address will be added to our “E” News distribution list. Updates are sent on a weekly basis including information about our upcoming events and Club news. Let us know if you update your email address or would like to add additional addresses eg. spouse or assistant. View our events calendar online at thehamiltonclub.com.

Can I invite guests to our Club events?

Certainly! Guests are most welcome at our Club events and may settle payment directly.

Are children permitted at the Club?

Absolutely! Children are welcome to dine or attend our events where applicable. Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Does the Club offer wireless internet?

We do! Inquire at the front desk for the pass code.

May I bring my own wine?

You can! Please let us know when making your dining reservation. Bottles brought to the Club must not be available on our wine list. A corkage fee will be charged.

What concierge services does my membership include?

Members of The Hamilton Club have access to V.I.P tickets to concerts, shows and theatre productions. Limousine & taxi service can be arranged and special gifts may be purchased.

What is the Club’s billing cycle?

The start of our fiscal year is December 1st. Annual memberships are pro-rated to the month joined. Memberships can be paid monthly, annually, quarterly or semi annually.

What other charges might I see on my account?

Other than your entrance fee (where applicable), dining charges, and annual dues, each member pays an annual charge of \$35 as a contribution to The Hamilton Club Art & Archives Committee Fund. There is a \$45 yearly administration charge for members that pay dues monthly or quarterly.

What is the Club Yearbook?

The Yearbook is a handbook that is published annually and distributed to our membership. It contains a complete listing of house rules and By-Laws. You will also find a directory of members with contact information and the Committee structure. Please ensure your contact information is up to date.
